It works to create a proactive, safe and sensitive environment which fosters perspectives, action, thought, and policies that are free of violence, patriarchy and gender based vulnerabilities.

- Presence in 368 villages and 48 slums of Bhuj
- Supported 3,800 women survivor of violence
- Reached out to 22,000 women, 350 youths and 75 leaders of 3 caste based societies through legal literacy campaign
